# Terry – ALS Detailed View by Bill Weis

### Requirements:


- 1. Be able to use voice to control TV
- 2. Be able to voice control his Reverie adjustable bed
- 3. Be able to use voice for Terry to ask for assistance

### Solution – High Level:

- 1. Provided an Amazon FireTV Cube to enable Terry to control his TV by voice
- 2. Terry's queen size Reverie bed has a 108 control box in it and adding the IOT dongle will provide the voice control of this bed.
- 3. Install two google minis to allow Terry to Broadcast a message to his caregiver

#### **Details of the Solution**

- **1 Be able to use voice to control the TV –** Terry wanted to control his Samsung TV by voice. They watch over-the-air local TV channels as well as internet-based entertainment from various sources including Netflix, YouTube, Prime, Hulu and others. We provided a Amazon Fire TV cube as the solution.
- **2 Voice Control his bed** Terry wants to be able to issue voice commands to his bed since ALS took away his ability to do this himself. Giving Terry the ability to move the bed frequently means his wife would not have to do this on his behalf throughout the day and night. Terry once again has control over his own comfort which translates to improved quality of life.



**3 – Be able to transmit a call for assistance –** We installed two Google Minis so Terry could do a broadcast message to alert his caregiver in a different room that he needs some assistance.
